Deer Verification Spreadsheet Instructions

The spreadsheet is not linked to the online NADR site.

The purpose of the spreadsheet is solely for electronic submissions to NADR and is not set up to be printed.

For dropdowns in the columns, click in the box below the column heading for drop down selections. If you are familiar with using Excel, you can use all of your time saving techniques in this spreadsheet as well such as copy and paste.

Member ID – Please provide your TDA number, your NADeFA number, or your VDM number. **Species** – 1 = White Tail; 4 = Mule

Animal Name – Please provide the name of the animal if it has been given one.

Ear Tag – Please provide each animal's ear tag number if it has such a number.

Breeder – Please provide the name of the breeder ranch.

Sex – M = Buck; F = Doe

Year Born – Please provide the 4 digit year in which the animal was born.

State Unique Number – Please provide the number assigned by the state in which the animal lives or another identifying number. (This number can be the state ID, the USDA number, or the microchip number. This number will print on your certificate.)

Animal Alive – Yes; No

Other Identifier – Please provide any other numbers or unique physical characteristics that may be used to identify the deer that you want to record in the registry. (This information will NOT print on your certificate.)

Specimen Type – Please provide the type of sample you are submitting for analysis. 1 = Antler, 3 = Blood, 6 = Hair, 8 = Semen, 9 = Tissue, 10 = Other

Specimen Type Other – If you identified "Other" as your specimen type, please describe the type of specimen you are submitting for analysis (for example – leg bone, arrow, etc.).

Lab Work Request – Please select one of the following: 1 = Profile and Compare to Animals Listed; 2 = Profile Only – No Comparisons Requested, 3 = Profile and Verify to Existing NADR #(s) on File (Identity Match)

Work Request Animal ID – If you selected #3 under Lab Work Request, please provide the DNAS #(s) for possible identity matches.

Compare NADR – Please provide all NADR number(s) of all possible sires and dams. (Separate the numbers by semi-colon ";").

Animal Comments – Please provide any additional comparison information in this field such as a specific farm for comparison.

CWD Protein DNA Test – This test is a genetic test (SNP) that predicts the sensitivity of the CWD rectal biopsy (live test for CWD) and is an additional \$10 per animal with parentage.
